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Project Narrative

Funding obtained through this grant will be used for the following metadata outreach and training activities:

1. Continuation of introductory metadata training to local and state spatial data creators, including members of the Northwest Indiana GIS Forum. GIS development among Northwest Indiana communities varies greatly. As communities develop and utilize GIS technology, we will continue to provide metadata outreach and training to support their development. Promotion of FGDC fully compliant metadata compilation will be stressed. Instruction will include how to search for metadata using the Geospatial One-Stop, <u>www.geodata.gov</u> website. Participants will also work with the Online Metadata Tool previously developed jointly by the Northwest Indiana GIS Forum and the Indiana Geological Survey.

Project progress:

October 18, 2007, Metadata presentation to ArcGIS 9.2 training session. Short presentation included basic metadata information. Most participants had very basic GIS skills. Also showcased new metadata features available in ArcGIS 9.2. Good initial contacts were made with personnel new to GIS who expressed their

Preparation of metadata training sessions is in progress. Current educational materials that currently exist are being personalized for our region. Half day metadata training sessions will be scheduled in the near future. Our Online Metadata Tool is currently being rebuilt by the Indiana Geological Survey due to changes in hardware. It is expected that the tool will be functional in December.

2. Many GIS professionals in Northwest Indiana and throughout the state are already familiar with metadata and FGDC metadata standards. In this case, we will create materials for more experienced spatial data creators familiar with metadata. These materials will be geared more towards data development practices. Funding would also be used for presentations using these training materials.

We will offer metadata outreach training activities to those organizations in Lake, Porter and LaPorte counties contributing data to this website.

Project Progress: A beta website has been created by the Indiana Geological Survey and testing is underway. Communities in Northwest Indiana continue to be contacted requesting their participation in providing spatial dataset for the website. All datasets will include FGDC compliant metadata. Metadata has been furnished for Gary and Hammond. Additional contacts with regional organizations have been made to acquire data for the website.
