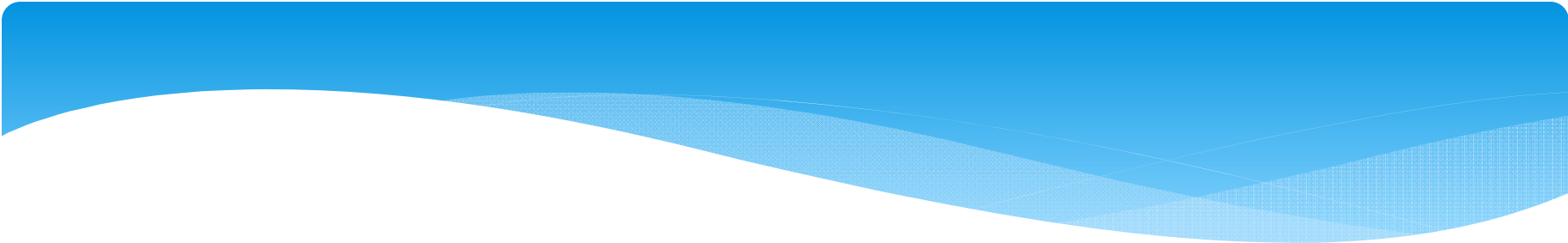

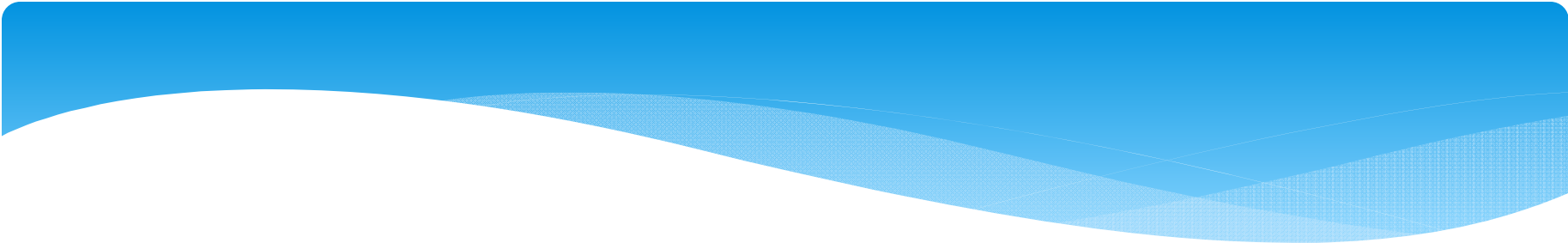

Communities Served

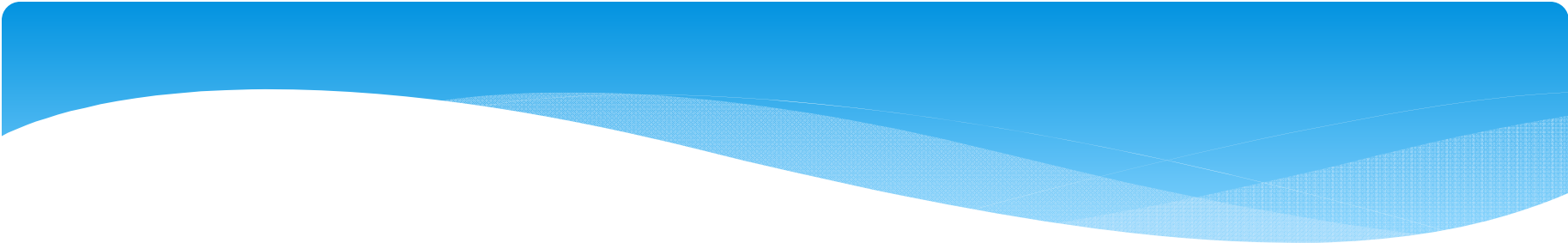
Miami-Dade County currently

Training & Outreach Approach

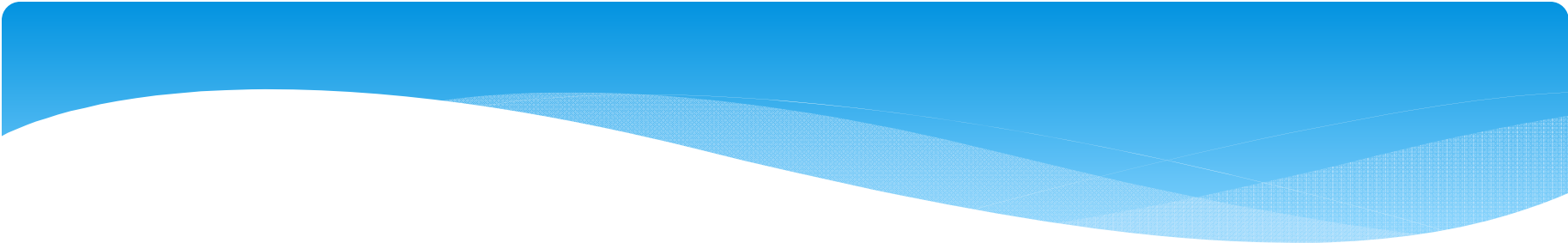
Will cover the following:

 - Web 2.0 or Wiki's will be explored.



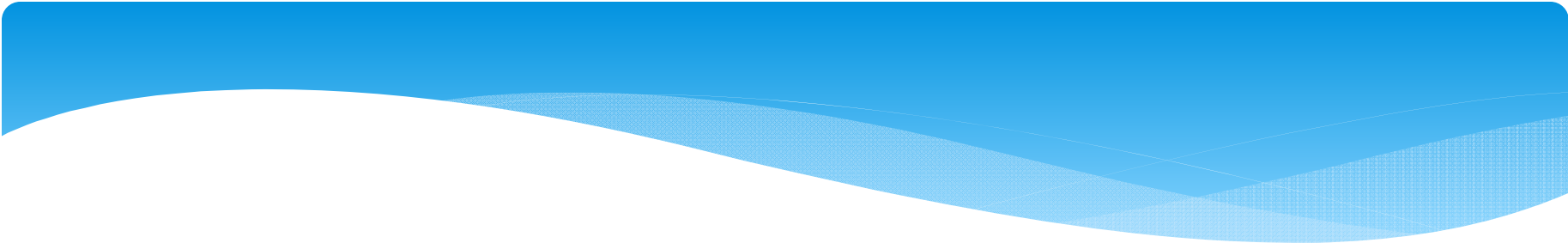
Timeline
