Geospatial Platform Business Plan/Business Case

Status

- ◆ Multiple rounds of review and comment: Coordination Group (12/11 – 1/12), Steering Committee/ExCom (2/12 – 3/12), NGAC (4/12 – 5/12)
- ◆ Business plan reviewed and discussed at April 19 Steering Committee meeting
- ◆ Several changes to address most recent comments:
 - Incorporated feedback and decisions made by the Steering Committee (e.g., governance model, Managing Partner agency, preferred funding option)
 - Addressed comments submitted by NGAC (e.g., linkage to IT reform and digital government strategies, revisions to Governance Model and role of the Platform Oversight Body)
- ◆ Business Case is being developed and funding levels have been entered in MAX system

Next Steps

- ◆ Complete Business Case
- ◆ Final adoption at Sept 20 Steering Committee meeting



Geospatial Cloud Computing Initiative Update

◆ Objectives:

- To deploy common software suites in the Cloud environment for service of data using standard protocols
- To share development expertise and lessons learned
- To develop common FedRAMP security documentation
- To provide 'incubator' leading to agency cloud operations

◆ Selected ten+ projects deploying either ArcGIS Server or OpenGeo Suite using secure Amazon Web Services in partnership with HHS and eGlobalTech

◆ Focus this year is on deployment of common software 'platforms' with Web Services for geospatial data to be registered with the Geospatial Platform

A-16 Portfolio Management

- ◆ Content for A-16 Theme subsites in the Geospatial Platform to be released 12/12
- ◆ Coordination Group has recommended 16 themes (redistributes datasets)
 - Remove: Cultural and Demographic Statistics
 - Expand: Governmental Units, and Administrative and Statistical Boundaries
- ◆ All themes have proposed lead agencies
- ◆ 15 of 16 have proposed theme leads
- ◆ Dataset identification continues

A-16 Portfolio Management

- ◆ Hold a series of webinars with theme managers and data set managers in October and November to start walking them through requirements.
- ◆ By November 15, 2012 each theme should begin work on the baseline for NGDAs within the theme.
- ◆ No later than December 1, 2012 at least 1 NGDA and associated services should be registered to the Geospatial Platform.
- ◆ This will necessitate having a data walk through which involves them documenting how they are meeting a variety of Lifecycle bench marks which will then be run through a maturity model to be documented on the Platform
- ◆ By October 1, 2013 all themes will have been expected to, at a minimum, have completed a baseline assessment for the NGDAs within their themes.
- ◆ Progress will be reported in an annual report to be released in the fall of 2013.



GAO Evaluation

- ◆ GAO evaluation of FGDC and OMB federal initiatives aimed at coordinating investments in geospatial data.
 - Have federal initiatives been effectively established and implemented to coordinate investments in geospatial data?
 - Does unnecessary duplication of investments in geospatial data continue to exist?
- ◆ In September, GAO presented statements of facts to each of the following:
 - FGDC leadership; OMB
 - 3 Departments/agencies with A-16 data responsibilities: DOI; DOC; DOT
- ◆ GAO is now preparing findings and recommendations



FGDC Standards Update

- ◆ The FGDC OS is continuing its review of CG member agency participation in standards activities.
- ◆ The FGDC OS has updated Chapter 10, Standards Suites for Spatial Data Infrastructure, of the SDI Cookbook.

Review Panel:

- Interagency review panel evaluating nominations and developing recommendations to DOI Office of the Secretary

Timeline:

- **Aug/Sept:** Review panel development of recommendations
- **September:** Appointments package submitted to Office of Secretary
- **Sept-Dec:** Appointments reviewed/approved/signed
- **Dec 31, 2012:** New appointments take effect
