- ◆ Task team meetings were held March 14 and March 24.
- ◆ FGDC participation on GWG Focus Groups is key to the success of FGDC GWG process integration.
- ◆ Responsibilities of FGDC representatives on GWG Focus Groups:
 - Participate in GWG Focus Group meetings.
 - Review standards under consideration by the GWG Focus Group.
 - Assess applicability of standards to FGDC business areas.
 - Identify other FGDC agencies that should be interested in a standard under GWG Focus Group consideration.
 - Recommend FGDC voting positions on Change Requests.
 - Communicate Focus Group activities to FGDC member agencies.
- ◆ USGS has nominated representatives to participate in several GWG Focus Groups.
- ◆ Task team is developing the process details, communication requirements, communications tools, timing requirements.
- ◆ The FGDC will identify additional standards in the DISR for consideration for FGDC endorsement: this is intended as a process of "catch-up" until the FGDC can align its process with the GWG/DISR standards process.


