- ◆ Develop approach and schedule for Business Plan development
- ◆ Develop the outline for Business Plan
- ◆ Create Component Development Teams and assign writing of Business Plan sections



NGAC Feedback on Business Plan

- ◆ Business case/plan must answer “Lingering Questions”
 - Who is managing it?
 - What agency is going to ensure and be the overall executive sponsor to manage and affirm quality of data from all sources?
 - Will federal agencies be required to use the Geospatial Platform?
 - Will federal funding be required to provide funding to support the platform?
 - What does it mean to “get on board?”
 - What am I responsible for? What do I get as a participant?
 - What are the rules to opt in or opt out?
 - What’s in it for me (WIIFM)?
 - What’s the leadership structure?
 - What do partners need to contribute - money, resources, time, or staff?



NGAC Feedback on Business Plan

- ◆ Define intended audience
- ◆ Focus on key agencies
- ◆ Leverage Value Proposition & answer questions: what, why, who, how much and from whom & by when.
- ◆ Include the basics – Executive Summary, products and services, management plan, marketing plan, financial plan, etc.
- ◆ Consider using *Ideascale* to request input for Case Studies
- ◆ Must be detailed enough to show the compelling cost benefits of the Platform in order to be competitive with other claimants for reduced federal dollars.
- ◆ Include something that demonstrates savings to taxpayers
- ◆ Include something that demonstrates reduction of staff time (e.g. searching for data)
- ◆ Environmental impact data overlay of demographics to show social impact

The content development team members are developing the Business Plan (BP) on behalf of the Steering Committee – concurrent reviews

- ◆ Nov 2, Wed – BP meeting: agreement on outline and writing assignments
- ◆ Weekly development team calls on progress and issues
- ◆ Nov 30, Wed – Due: Initial content from development team submitted to PMO for compilation
- ◆ Dec 7, Wed – Distribution: 1st draft BP sent from PMO to development team/CG/SC for review and comment
- ◆ Dec 16, Fri – Due: Development team/CG/SC edits/comments due to PMO
- ◆ Jan 11, Wed – Distribution: BP revised draft to development team/CG/SC
- ◆ Jan 31 (tentative SC meeting) – Presentation/discussion: BP revised draft at Steering Committee meeting

FGDC Standards Activities

- ◆ The Federal Trails Data Standards (FTDS) team is preparing the publication version of the standard now that the Steering Committee has endorsed the standard.
- ◆ The Coastal and Marine Ecological Classification Standard (CMECS) project team plans to have a final draft ready by January 9, 2012.
- ◆ Maintenance and Review of the National Wetland Classification Standard requires only minor changes to the standard. The project team is working with the FGDC Standards Coordinator on next steps.

INCITS L1 Standards Activities

- ◆ INCITS L1/U.S. TAG met Monday, October 31. Contentious issues:
 - The U.S. subject matter expert said that the project team for ISO 19103, Geographic information – Conceptual schema language has been unresponsive to U.S. comments. INCITS L1/U.S. TAG has authorized the U.S. delegation for the ISO/TC plenary to act on its behalf. INCITS L1/U.S. TAG agreed that the issue of non-responsiveness to U.S. comments should be raised at the ISO/TC 211 Plenary.
 - The DoD member of the INCITS Executive Board (EB) says that he will oppose ISO 19157, Geographic information – Data quality, going forward as an International Standard (IS), as he opines that there has been a lack of coordination with ISO 8000, Data quality. The U.S. subject matter expert disagrees, and says that ISO/TC 184, which is responsible for ISO 8000, should take the lead on coordination, as ISO 8000 post-dates TC 211 data quality standards.
- ◆ The ISO/TC 211 plenary and meetings are scheduled for November 13-18 in South Africa.
