Welcome and Introductions - Ivan DeLoatch, FGDC OS

Ivan welcomed participants to the meeting. It was noted that the 2012 FGDC Annual Report is now available. Next year we need to think about including financial information.

Previous Meeting Action Item Review - Ivan DeLoatch, FGDC OS

Action items were reviewed.

FGDC Business Report - Ken Shaffer, FGDC OS

Presentation

A summary of the ExCom meeting on December 20 was provided. ExCom members are providing their comments to the Secretariat on the FGDC and Commerce responses to the GAO recommendations. An ExCom member will lead or co-lead the 3 FGDC actions in response to the GAO recommendations. ExCom is also reviewing and commenting on the NSDI Strategic Plan planning document. ExCom will help develop guidance on issues for the NGAC for consideration in 2013. ExCom members discussed coordinating the multi-agency response to the GAO report recommendations. ExCom members are in the process of reviewing draft response documents and providing their comments to the FGDC OS. ExCom members also discussed the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau's proposed National Parcel Database and possible assistance from the geospatial community.. ExCom will meet before next March SC meeting.

John Mahoney reported on the status of NGAC. NGAC adopted two white papers: Geospatial Strategy Paper and National Address Database Paper. The 2013 Guidance for NGAC is being prepared.

ACTION: Coordination Group Members are requested to provide at least one suggestion per agency for 2013 NGAC Guidance to John Mahoney by January 31, 2013.

NGAC appointments are being processed the announcement on the new members will happen shortly.. The next meeting of the NGAC for 2013 will be:

- o April 2-3 Shepherdstown, WV (NCTC)
- o June 11-12– Washington, DC (AIA)
- o September 10-11– Washington, DC (AIA)

John also reported on the meeting with the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau in December 2012. New authority has been given to them to collect and develop a parcel/address database. CFPB is evaluating options on how to implement this authority. They are identifying subject matter experts to assist in evaluating the development of national parcels database and associated questions. FGDC would like to schedule a follow-up meeting with subject matter experts from FGDC agencies

ACTION: CG Members interested in participating in a meeting with Consumer Financial Protection Bureau regarding the development of a national parcel database should contact John Mahoney.

Wendy Blake-Coleman noted that the EPA emergency response community could provide assistance. Bill Burgess stated that there are States with statewide cadaster databases that may have been contacts already.

The next CG meeting will take place on Tuesday, February 19, 9:00 a.m. -3:00 p.m. ET at NCPC. Ken noted that the date of the June CG meeting has changed to June 4.

The Federal Metadata Coordinators ISO Implementation Workshop will take place in April 2013. Participation will focus on data managers and theme leads that implement processes and policies. Potential participants should contact Jen Carlino by January 31, in accordance with the prior action item.

The response to the GAO recommendations included an action plan to address the recommendations and will be submitted by January 31st.

The following are three GAO's recommendations relevant to the FGDC:

1. Develop a plan with timeframe to facilitate the implementation of OMB's portfolio management guidance (goals, performance measures, annual reporting to OMB).

Target Date: FY 2014, Q1

Responsible Officials: Ivan DeLoatch, FGDC OS; and Adrian Gardner, NASA

2. Develop and implement guidance and timeframe for identifying planned geospatial investments using the Geospatial Platform.

Target Date: FY 2013, Q4

Responsible Officials: Jerry Johnston, DOI

3. Create and update the NSDI strategic plan and implement the plan within the established time frame

Target Date: FY 2014, Q1

Responsible Officials: Ivan DeLoatch, FGDC OS; and Daniel Cotter, DHS.

The FGDC is coordinating with partner agencies to minimize duplication in strategic planning actions in response to the GAO Report. The FGDC will include stakeholders in the NSDI Strategic Plan process. A visioning workshop will be held in March to kick-off the process.

An update on the Geospatial Line of Business/Platform was provided. There are still 6 outstanding funding agreements. Shawn Gravatt (COMSO) introduced the new members of the team from COMSO. On GeoPlatform 2.0, Shawn noted that the team has completed the "wireframe" for the redesign of the GeoPlatform website, and they are awaiting final delivery of the "Communities" module in Drupal 7.0. The new instance of Drupal with final documentation is pending delivery to COMSO by January 18.

An update on FGDC Standards Activities included information on the Standards Working Group's next meeting which will be held on January 30, from 9:30 AM-3:30 PM at NOAA Silver Spring, MD. A review of CAP Standards Projects was given, as well as activities involving INCITS L1/U.S. TAG Standards, OGC Standards Activities, and GWG Standards Activities

ACTION: Coordination Group members should work with the Steering Committee to identify candidates for participation in the March 5 Strategic Visioning Workshop. John Mahonev will send out an email request for participants.

ACTION: Coordination Group members should send in their suggestions for members of the NSDI Strategic Plan Communications and Writing Teams to John Mahoney.

Ivan asked CG members to respond with suggestions or comments on the plan. The Strategic Plan will be a high level document: ideally about 20 pages, and have a supporting document with more specific actions. Tony LaVoi stated that this is an opportunity to fully engage with non-feds which was underemphasized in the past. Dick Vraga suggested that we may need contract support to develop the plan for areas where we may need assistance – quantifying resources. Wendy Blake-Coleman suggested the need to be consistent, and the need to make sure we don't under estimate the level of required effort on identified tasks to keep us from overcommitting.

Data.gov Catalog and Geospatial Platform Integration – Doug Nebert, FGDC OS

Presentation

Doug provided a presentation on the integration of records between data.gov and the Geospatial Platform. Records that are currently registered should be reviewed to ensure they are still current. Work continues on determining how to properly tag records so that they can be targeted through filtering. The guidance on how agencies should tag their records for search is in development. The registration process, once completed, should be easier than the previous approach for data.gov. The Open Data Policy will likely have impact on the registration requirements. The CG is interested in learning more about the Open Data Policy.

ACTION: Arista Maher will work with Doug Nebert to schedule a future Coordination Group presentation on Open Data plans.

The Geospatial Platform Marketplace is targeted for the completion this fiscal year. The approach is that agencies planning to invest in data will create a metadata record tagged as a planned investment and post it to the marketplace for discovery and collaboration. The policy/guidance for how to do this is still to be developed.

Wetlands Subcommittee Report - Bill Wilen, FWS

Annual Report is very important – shows who all the partners are and provides a perspective on the community – it's not just our program.. The Subcommittee has received good benefit from FGDC activities including: Becloud Sandbox – thanks to Doug Nebert for his support; CAP project, provided Wetland training; mapping implementation plan for wetland mapping – sponsored by EPA; helping with mapping standard, hosting info sessions, and online training. The National Wetlands Program was asked to provide support to identify structures in New Jersey that were in COBRA – coastal flood zones, after Hurricane Sandy. No funding was provided to support this requirement. They were able to stand-up an online geospatial tool to enable users to identify a structure's location and make a determination on whether it was in or out of the zones. This was a great use of online geospatial tools that enable the program to meet a requirement they otherwise would not have been able to address.

Marine and Coastal Spatial Data Subcommittee Report - Tony LaVoi, NOAA

Presentation
