Welcome and Introductions - Ivan DeLoatch, FGDC OS

Ivan DeLoatch, Chair, of the FGDC Coordination Group welcomed participants and invited them to introduce themselves.

Previous Meeting Action Item Review – Lucia Foulkes, FGDC OS

The action items from prior meetings were reviewed.

FGDC Business Report – Ken Shaffer, FGDC OS

Ken Shaffer reported that on the last Steering Committee meeting on September 25, the chair reiterated the need for a CG Co-Chair and exhorted members to nominate. It was announced that Ms. Jennifer Gimbal may be assuming the responsibilities of Ms. Castle, former Chair, of the FGDC Steering Committee; confirmation is to be announced soon.

There are updates on the Coordination Group and Steering Committee membership, the new members are: William Spencer James, replacing Alex Ferry as NGA’S CG member and Senior Agency Officials for Geospatial Information (SAOGI), William Nye, DOD-USACE replaces Nancy Blyler as USACE’S CG primary member, Peggy Carr, DE, replaces John Easton as SAOGI and Michel Kareis, GSA, replaces John Sullivan as GSA’s CG member.

In the last meeting, the National Advisory Committee (NGAC) approved a resolution in support of the development of a National Address Database. A second resolution was passed in regards to the departure of Ms. Anne Castle. The resolution recognizes Ms. Castle’s major contributions to the advancement of the national geospatial community. The next NGAC meeting will be on December 3, 2014.

A report of the FGDC business update was provided. It was reported that the 2014-GAO engagement action status indicated that the draft report in connection to the letter received in January 6, 2014 will be provided in December, 2014 for agency review and comment, and the final report is estimated to be released in February, 2015.

A summary of the National Geospatial Data Assets Plan activities was provided. Completed actions included: Action 1A.1: “Develop a Process for Selecting and Maintaining Executive NGDA Theme Champions, NGDA Theme Leads and NGDA Dataset Managers”, the NGDA Metadata Focus Group Metadata guidance, and updates of the registration instructions.

The FGDC business report included the status on the National Spatial Data Infrastructure (NSDI) Strategic Plan, including NSDI Implementation progress. It was noted that the FGDC sent a request to the Executive Champions for FY 14 status reports on the NSDI action plans, responses are in final review.

The Geospatial Line of Business and Geospatial Platform status noted the ongoing progress the on manager partner activities, the advancing of A-16 NGDA efforts, and site specific activities on Geoplatform.gov.

Ken Shaffer announced the migration of the FGDC Collaboration site to myUSGS.gov. Tutorial and additional information will be provided at the upcoming CG meeting.

An update on FGDC Standards activities and action items was reviewed. The Geopackage and GENC edition2 are recommended for FGDC endorsement.

Revitalizing the Coordination Group Meetings, Ivan DeLoatch, FGDC, OS

Ivan DeLoatch pointed out that the purpose of the discussion is to revisit the proceedings of the Coordination Group Meetings. Mr. DeLoatch discussed the Coordination Group Charter and noted the responsibilities of the Coordination Group to support the National Spatial Data Infrastructure (NSDI). Mr. DeLoatch emphasized that the Coordination Group is accountable to, and provides recommendations to, the FGDC Steering Committee and its Executive Committee. Comments and questions were received in connection to the reinvigoration effort. A workshop to shape the meetings and face to face meeting will be organized in the January/February time frame.

Metadata Working Group, Jennifer Carlino, FGDC, OS

Ms. Jennifer Carlino reported on discussion topics from the September 10, 2014 Metadata Working Group. The meeting summaries and presentations are available at <http://www.fgdc.gov/participation/working-groups-subcommittees/mwg/index.html>. Some of the outcomes of the September meeting were to increase understanding of the relationship among the International Organization for Standardization (ISO) and metadata standards. The Broad Metadata Best Practices document update, ISO Metadata Implementation Forum, and the ISO Geospatial Metadata Editors Registry projects are in progress. The paperwork Reduction Act approval is underway. The Pilot site is operational and software developers are engaging for testing.

Vegetation Subcommittee, Marianne Burke, Chair, FS

A summary of recent developments was shown. Some of the major accomplishments of the Subcommittee administration included the following:

1. The Vegetation Subcommittee Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) has been signed
2. The Subcommittee Implementation Plan has been drafted;
3. Hierarchy Revision document is being printed by Forest Service as a multi-agency document;
4. The Forest Service funded a contractor to evaluate what it will take to house the National Vegetation Classification (NVC) on the FS server;
5. The paper in Ecology and Environment to Frontiers has been submitted;
6. Finalized a pilot project testing the peer review process for identifying types and performing modifications to types described in the NVC Standard.
7. Finalized the NSDI Cooperative Agreements Program project with the California Native Plant Society and the California Dept. Fish and Game.
8. Provided cooperative agreement from Forest Service to Ecological Society of America
9. New FS-ESA agreement has been developed and will be submitted to the Forest Service. .

Connected Vehicles and Digital Infrastructure, Carl Andersen, DOT

Mr. Carl Andersen presented on the “Connected Vehicles” initiative sponsored by the Department of Transportation. The Connected Vehicles program is a multimodal initiative that aims to enable, safe interoperable, networked wireless communications among vehicles, the infrastructure, and passengers’ personal communication devices. Mr. Andersen remarked that the main benefit of the program involves the safety of drivers on roads. The communication technology consists in a Wi-Fi radio adapted for vehicle environment, and its functionality involves messages transmitted 10 times/sec (300m range-line of sight). Basic safety message includes: vehicle position, speed, heading, acceleration, size, brake system status, to name a few. Privacy is protected (vehicle location is not tracked). Other communications modes include cellular 4G, satellite and fiber optic. Mr. Andersen noted that assistance and guidance of the FGDC on how to develop data structure will be of great value in this initiative.
