### **Welcome and Introductions, Ivan DeLoatch, FGDC OS**

Ivan DeLoatch, Coordination Group Chair welcomed participants to the web meeting. Attendee introductions were made and a brief overview of agenda was provided.

### **Previous Meeting Action Item Review, Lucia Foulkes, FGDC OS**

The action items from December were reviewed.

Marcia McNiff (USGS) provided a status on the action in relation to the proposal to change the name of the Biota NGDA Theme. She reported that a request to change the name of the “Biota Theme” including justification was submitted to the FGDC Chair. Ivan DeLoatch acknowledged the receipt of the document, and suggested to share the proposal with the Data Theme Community, and subsequently with the Coordination Group for consideration.

**Action:** The proposal to change the name of the “Biota Theme” to “Biodiversity and Ecosystems Theme” will be shared with the Data Theme community.

### **FGDC Business Highlights, Ken Shaffer, FGDC OS**

Ken Shaffer, FGDC OS, provided an update on FGDC activities. Highlights included the following:

#### **Committee's Summary**

The Steering Committee held a meeting on Thursday, December 10<sup>th</sup>. Discussion topics included FGDC Current Activities, Cadastral Theme Reporting, HUD eGIS Briefing, Survey for Data Acquisition Vehicles, and the December 4<sup>th</sup> NGAC meeting summary.

The Executive Committee (ExCom) had conference call meeting on November 19<sup>th</sup> to discuss the following: the Geo Investments Definitions Document and Next Steps, NDOP initial recommendations on the feasibility of a national imagery initiative, and the FGDC 2016 key priority milestones.

The National Geospatial Advisory Committee (NGAC) held a web meeting on December 4<sup>th</sup>. John Mahoney reported that the NGAC approved the paper "The Changing Landscape: A Second Look". The paper will be available on the FGDC website. This paper could potentially generate ideas for the next version of the NSDI Strategic Plan. The subcommittees provided their summary report and final products. These reports and detailed information are available at: <http://www.fgdc.gov/ngac/meetings/december-2015/index.html>. Mr. Mahoney reported on the CIO Privacy Summit and noted that updates and revisions will be made to OMB policy documents on privacy, such as OMB Circular A-130 & Circular A-108.

Secretary Sally Jewell has appointed new leadership for the NGAC; Julie Sweetkind-Singer was appointed as the new NGAC Chair, and Keith Masback as the Vice Chair. The 2015 NGAC appointment process is scheduled to be completed in January.

#### **Architecture & Technology Working Group (ATWG)**

The working group will support the operations of the Geospatial Platform. The ATWG chair is Bill Mullen. The charter is currently in review within the group. On December 16, 2015 the first meeting was held to discuss roles of the ATWG in supporting the Geospatial Platform, as well as the ATWG role in supporting the FGDC. The next meeting will discuss Historical Context, Technical Overview, and Planned Development Activities of the Geospatial Platform. #### **Government Accountability Office (GAO)**

The FGDC provided GAO the link to the 2015 NSDI Strategic Plan FY 2015 Status report to GAO. The report is available at <http://www.fgdc.gov/nsdi-plan/index.html>

#### **National Geospatial Data Asset (NGDA)**

Gita Urban-Mathieux, FGDC, reported that the NGDA Dataset Life Maturity Assessment (LMA) results are being analyzed. The Theme Leads, Dataset Managers, and the Coordination Group are reviewing the LMA Performance Dashboard, Dataset Report, and the Theme Summary Report. The feedback of 106 comments is being adjudicated, and updated reports will be shared during the Theme Leads meeting on January 21<sup>st</sup>. Marcia McNiff, USGS, will be presenting the proposal to change the name of the Biota Theme at the Theme Leads meeting on January 21<sup>st</sup>. The NGDA Web Services and Metadata project was briefly discussed. The goal is to provide reliable web services with quality metadata to improve the Geoplatform experience. The initial prototype of the Geoplatform's NGDA Collaboration Community that has been updated will be presented at the January 21<sup>st</sup> Theme Lead meeting. The evaluation project of the NGDA Management Plan will be discussed at the Theme Lead session during the Esri GIS conference on February 25<sup>th</sup>.

#### **National Spatial Data Infrastructure (NSDI) Plan**

John Mahoney, FGDC OS, reported that the status report was distributed to the FGDC community, NGAC, and GAO. The report summarizes FGDC performance in addressing FY 2014 and 2015 goals, and it includes updated FY 2016 targets. The FGDC is brainstorming on the next version of the NSDI plan, and how to improve targets and goals.

#### Geospatial Line of Business

Roxanne Lamb, FGDC OS, reported that the POC list is being prepared as part of the 2016 interagency agreement process. CG members were asked to notify and confirm the current agency POCs on the list.

#### 2015 FGDC Annual Report

The annual report draft is in review with the editing staff; the next step is to share it with the CG.

#### FGDC Website

The FGDC has been working over the past year on updating its website. A Beta version of the new website will be launched during the CG meeting in February. CG members and select groups will be given an opportunity for a Beta review. Official public launch will be in early March.

#### Revised CG Charter, Ivan DeLoatch, FGDC

Ivan DeLoatch reported on recent updates made on the charter. A marked up version of the suggested changes addressing co-chairmanship was displayed for CG members to review.

Members discussed the charter and made the following comments:

- Concern about the impact of rotational basis on agencies already actively involved in CG activities.
- Reevaluate the necessity of a co-chair since co-chairmanship role has been vacant for over 2 years.
- If co-chair serves on rotational basis, it’s critical to develop a plan indicating timelines to ensure commitment.
- Modify language to reflect that at the discretion of the CG chair, a co-chair may be appointed in concurrence with the CG.

CG members agreed to include language in the charter stating that at the discretion of the CG chair, a co-chair may be appointed within the CG, and in concurrence with the CG membership.

**Action: The FGDC Secretariat will modify the Coordination Group charter, and update the chairmanship role section. The charter will be submitted to the CG for an electronic vote due back by January 22<sup>nd</sup>.**

#### Evaluation of the NSDI Strategic Plan and NGDA Management Plan, Ivan DeLoatch, FGDC OS

Ivan DeLoatch reported that the FGDC is planning to conduct an assessment of the value of the NGDA Management Plan, and the NSDI Strategic Plan to the geospatial community. He noted that during the last transition to new political leadership, it was beneficial to have a transition paper to highlight the value of geospatial technology. The objective of this evaluation is to develop a framework for the next strategic plans. The evaluation will consist in an analysis of the work performed by the community, the CG, Theme Leads, and the PMO. The PMO will conduct this analysis.

The NSDI strategic plan covers FY2014 and FY 2016. The next version of the NSDI Strategy will consider FGDC priority areas for 2016, and engagement with other external partners including COGO. The plan should ensure a national scope. The NSDI future strategy will be a key focus for the NGAC activities in 2016. Initial conversations with COGO leadership indicated that COGO is interested in engaging with FGDC activities, however, confirmation of the level of involvement is pending.

The NGDA Management Plan will evaluate efforts to establish the A-16 portfolio management. We want to make sure we address the goals of the supplemental guidance. The plan is that the evaluation on the NGDA will include analysis of the results of the actions, and identify outcomes, successes, and challenges.

CG members were invited to provide feedback and discussed the proposed evaluation. Comments made:

- There is value in LMA, and dataset registration, and establishing communication with dataset managers and theme leads. Geoplatform.gov needs to mature as well.
- Ensure that the results of the work are being utilized, and invest in appropriate resources that will benefit the community.
- Evaluation should assist in identifying what goals to pursue and connect to the activities agencies are doing.

CG members welcomed the evaluation project and were interested in having a discussion on this topic in the next CG meeting.
