Welcome and Introductions, Ivan DeLoatch, FGDC OS

Ivan DeLoatch, Coordination Group chair welcomed the attendees to the Coordination Group meeting. All participants introductions were made.

The FGDC Chair noted that an ongoing CG action is the FGDC's request for topics to develop the CG agenda. Ivan DeLoatch encouraged member agencies to submit topics of their interest to assist building the monthly agendas.

FGDC Business Highlights, Ken Shaffer, FGDC OS

Ken Shaffer reported on FGDC business activities. Highlights included the following:

Transition Update

The FGDC met with the DOI transition team and reported on the activities of the implementation of OMB Circular A-16 Supplemental Guidance. In addition, the transition documents that were prepared by FGDC and the NGAC we also shared with the transition team and were well received. There was a request to follow up on the Geospatial Platform activities.

Kerry Rae, DOI Acting Principal Deputy Assistant Secretary for Water and Science will be the Acting FGDC chair until the administration identifies a permanent replacement. She will also participate in the NGAC meeting and will chair the Steering Committee meeting this month.

Ivan DeLoatch reported that the new Secretary of the Interior is Ryan Zinke. Mr. DeLoatch noted that in the near future FGDC will call the membership to identify new members.

Coordination Group Action

On March 3rd, 2017 the Coordination Group voted to approve the National Geospatial Data Asset (NGDA) Address Theme Definition. The next step is to send the vote to the Steering Committee for their approval.

Ivan DeLoatch reported on recent meetings and FGDC engagements as follows:

- Esri Federal GIS Conference: The Executive meeting was well attended. One of the outcomes was the ongoing importance of geospatial data not only in our country but internationally.
- National State Geographic Information Council (NSGIC) Mid-Year Conference: It was also a
 well-attended meeting. During the conference, Ivan DeLoatch shared with attendees the work on
 the National Geospatial Data Asset (NGDA) Management Plan and the Lifecycle Maturity
 Assessment (LMA).
- Coalition of Geospatial Organizations (COGO): COGO is offering FGDC the opportunity to
 participate in the developing process of their criteria for the next report card. An action from this
 meeting was to identify a representative. A second opportunity is to review the report card before
 is published. COGO expressed interest to participate in the building and development of the
 FGDC strategic framework.

Government Accountability Office (GAO)Engagement

The USGS is preparing their closing package in relation to the Water Inland Implementation Plan.

In reference to the action regarding the creation of the Address Theme and associated subcommittees, the GAO indicated that once the description of the address theme is posted on the website that action will be

closed.

National Geospatial Data Asset (NGDA) Portfolio Management Update

Jen Carlino, FGDC reported on the NGDA portfolio management activities as follows:

- Restarting web services and metadata project: FGDC is reaching out to dataset managers and theme leads to complete those updates. Federal and non-federal metadata publishers are required to have an OMB max account.
- Theme Implementation Status: The framework themes provided an update. The Water Inland Theme Implementation Plan is completed.
- 2015 NGDA Portfolio Summary Report: The Coordination Group will see a draft of the NGDA portfolio summary report. This report aggregates information across all themes.
- 2017 LMA: The assessment consists on the evaluation of the maturity of data. The assessment question is in development.

Geologic Data Subcommittee Report, David Soller, USGS

Dave Soller, Geologic Data Subcommittee chair reported on their activities.

Mr. Soller talked about the Geologic Mapping Act of 1992 and noted that under this authority, on behalf of Federal agencies and the State Geological Surveys (AASG), the National Geologic Map Database coordinates development of geologic map standards and guidelines.

Mr. Soller noted that the standards that are selected for consideration and adoption by the FGDC are presented to the Geologic Data Subcommittee for their evaluation, public review, and adoption by the FGDC.

Mr. Soller discussed the status of the FGDC Geologic Map Symbolization Standard and reported that because of lack of resources the standard will not be updated at this time. Mr. Soller also talked about the Standard Schema for Geologic Map Database and pointed out that the challenge of adoption of standards is to convey its significance and use.

Mr. Soller talked about the NCGMP09 Schema for Geologic Map Database and reported that a second version is being prepared. The NCGMP09 Version 2 was renamed as Geologic Map Schema or GeMS. It's expected to be published later this year. Mr. Soller indicated that resources will be needed in order to conduct the public review and prepare the standard for consideration by the FGDC. He also noted that the subcommittee is working on identifying those resources within USGS. Mr. Soller highlighted that one of the values in having the standard is the benefit that will bring to the emergency response community.

Mr. Soller talked about 3D mapping, and pointed out that one of the challenges in working with geologic mapping and 3D is to find adequate equipment and software. According to Mr. Soller the discussion of 3D geologic mapping should be about how to manage the database in respect to how it's displayed. How can geologic mapping support the nation infrastructure needs and disaster response? Mr. Soller indicated that the subcommittee can assist to reinforce and convey the importance of geologic mapping to help disaster response and mitigation.

<u>Homeland Infrastructure Foundation Level Data (HILFD) Subcommittee Report, Michael Donnelly, DHS</u>

Michael Donnelly from the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) reported on the activities of the Homeland Infrastructure Foundation Level Data (HIFLD) Subcommittee. Mr. Donnelly noted that Tod Dabolt, DOI is the current HILFD subcommittee chair.

Mr. Donnelly reported that HIFLD has been very active during FY2016. Some of the accomplishments included launching HIFLD Open (<u>URL: https://gii.dhs.gov/hifld/data/open</u>) for unclassified data and HILFD Secure (<u>URL: https://gii.dhs.gov/hifld/data/secure</u>) which contains FOUO and access to commercially licensed data layers. Currently, there is work in place to develop an enabling approach on HILFD Secure so users don't go back and forth between two databases.

The FY2017 plan is to ensure that the data obtained from the providers are useful and accurate.

Mr. Ivan DeLoatch inquired about the type of users on HILFD Secure. Mr. Donnelly noted that the vetting process to obtain DHS Geospatial Information Infrastructure (GII) Homeland Security Information Network (HSIN) data is to open an account. For federal users; a federal email account is needed. For state users; same rules as the federal community apply. For local users; they go through a sponsorship, and contactors will be asked about their respective agency to be provided with an account.

In concluding his presentation Mr. Donnelly noted that HILFD will continue its focus on delivery of data and improve capabilities and outreach. He also indicated that HILFD wants to leverage existing resources with FGDC to improve services through the Geospatial Platform.

The Capital Planning and Investment Control (CPIC) reporting is complete. Member agencies were encouraged to execute the interagency agreements for the Geospatial Platform support.
