#### Welcome and Introductions, Ivan DeLoatch, FGDC OS

Ivan DeLoatch welcomed CG members to the May CG meeting. Attendee introductions were made.

# Previous Meeting Action Item Review, Lucia Foulkes, FGDC OS

The actions from the April meeting were reviewed.

### FGDC Business Highlights, Ken Shaffer, FGDC OS

Ken Shaffer reported on FGDC business activities.

#### Committee Decision Summary

A designation letter will be sent out to the Steering Committee member agencies through the President's Management Council to designate their Senior Agency Official for Geospatial Information (SAOGI). FGDC is awaiting an update on this process.

#### CG and SC Membership Changes

No changes this month.

#### Steering Committee

The SC meeting is currently scheduled for June 28th. Once SAOGIs are identified, the FGDC OS will hold an orientation for the SAOGIs.

#### Executive Committee

The Executive Committee met on April 5<sup>th</sup> to discuss the following:

- April 3-4 NGAC Meeting Summary
- National Aerial Imagery Program (NAIP) Data Licensing
- OGC Disasters Interoperability Concept Development Study
- Geospatial Platform
- National Spatial Data Infrastructure (NSDI) Strategic Plan

There was a formal request for comments from OMB on the Farm Bill that included a section on NAIP. The request was sent directly to the agencies for internal review and comment.

# National Geospatial Advisory Committee (NGAC)

The NGAC met on April 3-4, 2018. Subcommittee activities:

- <u>Landsat Advisory Group (LAG)</u>: The LAG will work on a paper in response to task 3 addressing fee recovery options for Landsat data. The team will provide a status report at the June NGAC meeting.
- <u>Data as a Service Subcommittee</u>: A draft paper including use cases describing current and future needs for data as service will be presented at the June meeting.
- <u>Cultural & Historical Resources Subcommittee</u>: A series of interviews will be conducted to inform a paper making recommendations and best practices for the protection and access to geospatial cultural and historical data.
- <u>Infrastructure Subcommittee</u>: They are working on developing use cases, an infographic and white paper demonstrating the uses of geospatial tools for infrastructure management.
- <u>GeoPlatform Feedback</u>: Per NGAC's request, the FGDC will hold a series of webinar sessions to demonstrate capabilities of the GeoPlatform and capture feedback from NGAC members.
- <u>National Address Database</u>: The NGAC approved a resolution to continue development of the National Address Database (NAD).

The NGAC call for nomination will be released in early June. The next NGAC meeting is on June 26-27 at DOI.

#### NGDA Portfolio Management

Lorna Schmid reported on portfolio management activities.

- NGDA Portfolio Management: Implementations Plans are in progress. Theme summary reports are close to completion.
- NGDA Portfolio Support: Ardent MC has provided support in multiple projects including finalizing various theme reports, theme community updates on GeoPlatform, and metadata and web services project.
- Proposed NGDA changes to Cadastre and Imagery Themes: Theme Leads are proposing changes to the Cadastre and Imagery Themes. Once theme leads obtain approval from their lead agency, the request will be forward to the CG. Ms. Dierdre Bevington-Attardi (Census Bureau) noted that one of the proposed changes to the Cadastre Theme involved datasets that are currently part of the Governmental Units Theme. The NGDA Coordinator and Ms. Bevington-Attardi will discuss the proposed changes. - NGDA Inventory and POC Updates: Drew Kenny will remain the sole theme lead for Soils as Dave Hoover will no longer serve as co-lead.

#### <u>Standards</u>

FGDC is preparing the ballot for the Coordination Group to vote on ISO standards 19115-3:2016 and 19157-2:2016.

#### Geospatial Data Act

The Office of Management and Budget (OMB) solicited comments on the Geospatial Data Act 2017 (<u>S.2128</u>). FGDC OS forwarded a notice of the receipt of this request to the Steering Committee to help make them aware it. Agencies were to coordinate their comments through their legislative affairs offices.

#### National Spatial Data Infrastructure (NSDI) Strategic Plan

FGDC had initial conversations with Tim Petty on the NSDI Strategic Plan, and will ensure that the plan aligns with the President's Management Agenda (PMA). FGDC asked for volunteers to participate in the NSDI Core Team and has received good response.

# GeoPlatform Support

GeoPlatform Release 11 included improvements on user login, registration, and account update screens. Release 12 is in process. There will be improvements to NGDA community toolkit enhancements on search and discovery features, and on-going improvements to the open API. There are many community sites in production and several others in development including GeoPathways (FGDC), Resilience (NASA), US Group on Earth Observations (USGEO), and Disasters (FEMA).

#### Spatial Water Data Subcommittee Report, Al Rea, USGS

Al Rea reported on the subcommittee activities. Mr. Rea spoke about the value of water information sharing and how to facilitate it. He also spoke about the Open Water Data Initiative (OWDI) and discussed the Open Water Web, which is the road map of the OWDI. In 2014, the OWDI started working with use cases to make sure there is data available to support these cases. There were 3 use cases:

- <u>Use Case 1 National Flood Interoperability Experiment</u>: This has been completed and has been very successful.
- <u>Use Case 2 Drought Decision Support System</u>: This effort is currently on hold. It focuses on balancing water usage across needs. To continue with this activity it is necessary to have representation from the Bureau of Reclamation on the SSWD, and for a new work group lead to be identified.
- <u>Use Case 3 Spill Response</u>: Efforts are on-going to identify the datasets needed to support this use case.

Mr. Rea provided an update on NHDPlus High Resolution and noted that public release of beta products began in April 2017. The goal for 2018 is to release of 70% of the area of the United States (including Alaska). He also talked about the Network-Linked Data Index (NLDI). The NLDI is a system that can index spatial and river network-linked data and navigate the river network to allow discovery of indexed information. The NLDI is a core product of the Open Water Data Initiative, which is coordinated with the Advisory Committee on Water Information (ACWI). NLDI is embedded in the Water Quality Portal (<a href="https://www.waterqualitydata.us/">https://www.waterqualitydata.us/</a>). The Environmental Protection Agency (EAP) has a similar functionality called new WATERS GeoViewer, in the future we will be able to use it with NLDI.

Mr. Rea noted some of the challenges to linked data:

- Planning for support and scaling up of common spatial data infrastructure
- Developing similar services for NHDPlus HR
- Hosting solutions for NLDI services
- Planning for services scaling-up based on demand
- Furthering development of functionality
- Identifying required funding support

Mr. Rea reported the subcommittee is discussing Inland bathymetric data as a new potential use case.

#### HILFD Subcommittee Report, Michael Donnelly, DHS; Tod Dabolt, DOI

Michael Donnelly reported on the HIFLD subcommittee accomplishments during FY 17 including migrating the HIFLD Open site to GeoPlatform.gov, working on communication and expanded reach of HIFLD Secure, establishing operational sites for 2017 hurricane season, and obtaining basic metrics through HIFLD4Harvey.

Mr. Donnelly noted the following priority areas for 2018. Key notes:

- Governance and subcommittee involvement: HIFLD Open published and compiled energy datasets including power plants, electric power transmissions lines, substations, generating units and interconnects. Arizona utility companies believe energy data should be removed from the public domain and be transferred to a more secure location. There have been several discussions on this topic. NGA, DOE, and ORNL discussed this issue and will hold a call with HILFD subcommittee Executive Secretariat/chairs, Arizona Utilities, National Protection and Programs Directorate (NPPD) and Protective Security Advisor (PSA).
- Data, Discoverability and Online Dissemination: Data Use Agreement (DUA), Licensed Data, new site for HIFLD access and informational page. NGA has worked to update the licensing for commodity purchased data to expand the breath of access for critical layers throughout the HLS mission space and partners. A DUA codifies who can use data and is being reviewed through DHS and NGA legal teams and will be ready for publication in approximately two months. Licensed Data accessible on HIFLD Secure includes transportation and parcel data. Because of vulnerability for licensed data, the site was taken down. The process to request data is currently manual (email). The site is estimated to be back online next month.
- Outreach and Events FY2018: HIFLD engaged in several outreach and support activities including Super Bowl NSSE, State of the Union NSSE, Esri Federal User Conference, FGDC Executive Committee meeting. HIFLD will continue to engage and participate in many more events during FY 2018.
